RETURN TO UNITS – EASY TO REMEMBER

The 2018 sale ushers in simple way to ALWAYS know what your unit earned at every point of the sale to support your incredible Scouting adventures. You keep 1/3 of EVERYTHING you sell. No hoops, no complicated equations...simply divide by three!

YOUR UNIT'S COMMISSION = 1/3

SHOW AND SELL ORDERING:

Option #1: A unit can place an ORDER for their Show and Sell product. If a unit chooses to go this route, they will need to:

- Enter the order in the Trails End System
- The order will not be modified by the PTAC Popcorn Team
- Returns will only be accepted up to 10% of your order

Option #2: A unit can place a REQUEST for their Show and Sell product. If a unit chooses to go this route, they will need to:

- Submit their request to PTAC.popcorn@Scouting.org
- The request may be modified by the PTAC Popcorn team in conjunction with the District Executive and the leadership of the unit. The order will be entered in the TE System by the PTAC Popcorn Team.
- There is NO LIMIT on RETURNS from REQUESTED product.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL RETURNS CAN ONLY BE ACCEPTED IN FULL CASES AND RETURNS ON CHOCOLATE CARAMEL CRUNCH ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

How to Place an Order:

- Log on to: Scouting.trails-end.com
- Enter your Username and Password

On the Home Page of Unit Leader Account

- Click white cluster of cubes at top left of screen
 - o Set available period to the current year: 2018 Fundraising Cycle, 2018 Selling Campaign
 - If you are kernel for multiple units, click on Available Roles to select the Unit you are currently working on
- Click the Popcorn Orders Tab then the New Unit Order
 - o Go to drop down menu at top of screen and select year (2018 Selling Campaign)
 - o Then select the order name: Show and Sell (Due 8/27/2018)
 - o Enter desired <u>case</u> quantities of each available product
- At top of page click on "save as draft" to submit later
- You may select submit if you are ready to send to Council for approval
- You will receive a green success notification when your order has been successfully saved and submitted

WHY DO WE ASK FOR THE PTAC ROSTER OF SELLING SCOUTS?

- 1) Prizes ordered through the Trails End system need to be verified by our Council office prior to shipment. We use this roster to verify orders.
- 2) Prize rosters are used to generate a list of Camp Cash recipients to create individual camp cash codes from our Camping Department. These codes need to be made available to unit leaders BEFORE the end of December since camp registrations begin January 1, 2019. Remember, names listed on the roster must be the same name and spelling of the youth registering for camp. For example, if Johnny Scout is placed on the roster of selling Scouts, they need to sign up for camp as Johnny Scout for the camp cash code to be valid. John Scout will not work if Johnny Scout was listed on the roster of selling Scouts.
- 3) Trails End College Scholarship applications are verified using the roster of selling Scouts.

EARN THE PTAC RACETRACK PATCH SET

Scouts can earn this PTAC Racetrack patch set by participating in this year's sale! Start off earning the center patch by selling 1 item. Scouts can then complete the set by earning segments for selling a military item, an online item, one of each item from the product mix (excluding online items) and by achieving the Sellers Club level which is \$750.00 in sales and also earns them a ticket to an end-of-sale achievement experience. Patches and segments will be ordered online by your Unit Kernel when prizes are ordered.



TRAIL'S END SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Drivers that cross the finish line unscathed by selling at least \$2500.00 in a calendar year will receive 6 of their total sales invested in their own college scholarship account. Once enrolled, 6% of any amount of sales thereafter will be added to their account. BONUS: Top 5 Scouts in each region receive an additional 6% added to their account. At the end of the sales, send your Scout's Scholarship forms and a copy of their order form(s) to PTAC.POPCORN@SCOUTING.ORG to verify and sign as Council Approval.
